- Develop and implement KOBE's Mental Health and Student Well-Being Strategy
- Provide board-wide leadership on mental health policies, education, and resources
- Oversee safe sober sites in Sioux Lookout, Dryden, and Thunder Bay
- Support capacity-building for educators and staff on mental health literacy
- Collaborate with community partners to develop service pathways for student support
- Ensure compliance with documentation and reporting requirements
- Travel to Northern First Nations communities and KOBE regional offices as needed

- Graduate degree (Master's or PhD) in Clinical/School Psychology, Psychiatry, or Social Work preferred
- 7-10 years of experience in mental health service delivery, ideally with First Nations students
- Experience in mental health strategy development and program implementation
- Registered with a professional regulatory body in Ontario or another province
- Knowledge of School Mental Health Ontario (SMHO) is an asset
